

**TOWN OF MANITOWOC RAPIDS
BID OPENING FROM APRIL 13, 2022**

Chairperson Stradal called the bid opening meeting to order at 6:30p.m. on April 13, 2022. Town Board Members present were Chairperson Stradal, 1st Supervisor Tom Wetenkamp, 2nd Supervisor John Jost, along with Road Foreman Stradal and Clerk/Treasurer Backus.

Clerk Backus informed the Board that the total Highway/Street Construction budget for this year was \$133,453.00.

Chairperson Stradal received two quotes for the Augusta Way emergency road project. One from Scott Construction and two options from Northeast Asphalt. Scott's constructions quote did not include excavating. There were two quotes for excavation from Bubholz Excavating and Tisler Trucking. Chairperson Stradal read the quote amounts. Chairperson Stradal moved to award the emergency project to Northeast Asphalt in the amount of \$16,460.00; seconded by Supervisor Jost. Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.

The Highway/Street Construction budget was reduced to \$116,993.00 because of the emergency road repair for Augusta Way.

Chairperson Stradal stated one bid was received from Northeast Asphalt for the three portions of the parking lot. Chairperson Stradal read the bid amounts.

Chairperson Stradal stated one bid was received from Northeast Asphalt for the three repaving projects. Chairperson Stradal read the bid amounts.

Chairperson Stradal stated one bid was received from Scott Construction for the three chip sealing projects. Chairperson Stradal read the bid amounts.

Chairperson Stradal stated one bid was received from Scott Construction for the various wedging locations. Chairperson Stradal read the bid amounts.

Chairperson Stradal stated one bid was received for from Struck and Erwin for the resurfacing projects. Chairperson Stradal read the bid amounts.

Supervisor Jost moved to award, the only bidder, Northeast Asphalt the bid for the front portion of the parking lot in the amount of \$42,480.00 and reject the bids for the other parking lot portions; seconded by Supervisor Wetenkamp. Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Wetenkamp moved to award, the only bidder, Struck & Irwin the resurfacing project of Michigan Ave in the amount of \$26,567.77 and reject the bids for the other resurfacing projects; seconded by Supervisor Jost. Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.

Chairperson Stradal moved to award, the only bidder, Scott Construction the chip sealing project of Goodwin Rd in the amount of \$17,542.00 and reject the bids for the other chip sealing projects; seconded by Supervisor Wetenkamp. Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.

Chairperson Stradal moved to award, the only bidder, Scott Construction the wedging by selecting three out of the seven various locations in the amount of \$17,490.00 and reject the bids for the other wedging projects; seconded by Supervisor Jost. Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.

Chairperson Stradal moved to reject all the repaving bids; seconded by Supervisor Wetenkamp. Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.

After all the bids/projects were awarded the Highway/Street Construction budget had \$12,913.23 available for unexpected road issues.

Supervisor Wetenkamp moved to adjourned at 7:01 p.m., seconded by Supervisor Jost. Unanimously approved.
