

**TOWN OF MANITOWOC RAPIDS  
BID OPENING FROM MAY 13, 2026**

Supervisor Wetenkamp called the bid opening meeting to order at 6:33 p.m. on May 13, 2026. Town Board Members present were Supervisor Tom Wetenkamp, Supervisor Jost, Road Foreman Stradal and Clerk/Treasurer Backus. Chairman Stradal was excused.

Clerk Backus informed the Board that the total Highway/Street Construction budget for this year was \$148,000.00.

Clerk Backus stated one bid was received from Scott Construction for the chip-sealing and wedging projects and read the bid amounts.

Clerk Backus stated one bid was received from Struck and Erwin for the resurfacing projects and read the bid amounts.

Clerk Backus stated two bids were received for the culvert project and read the bid amounts. Bids were from Vinton Construction and Alfson Excavating.

Supervisor Wetenkamp moved to award the following bidders and projects: Struck and Erwin the resurfacing project of Victoria Dr for \$12,317.30 and Branch River Rd for \$32,998.00; Scott's Construction the chipseal projects of Village Dr for \$23,237.00 and Middle Rd for \$32,911.00, and the wedging projects of Hershau Rd for \$4,955.00, S Union Rd for \$8,795.00, N Union Rd for \$4,995.00, and Stone Rd for \$8,795.00; Alfson Excavating the culvert project of Middle Rd for \$18,920.00; and reject all other bids; seconded by Supervisor Jost. Upon discussion and vote, the motion was carried unanimously.

Supervisor Wetenkamp moved to adjourned at 6:51 p.m., seconded by Supervisor Jost. Unanimously approved.
